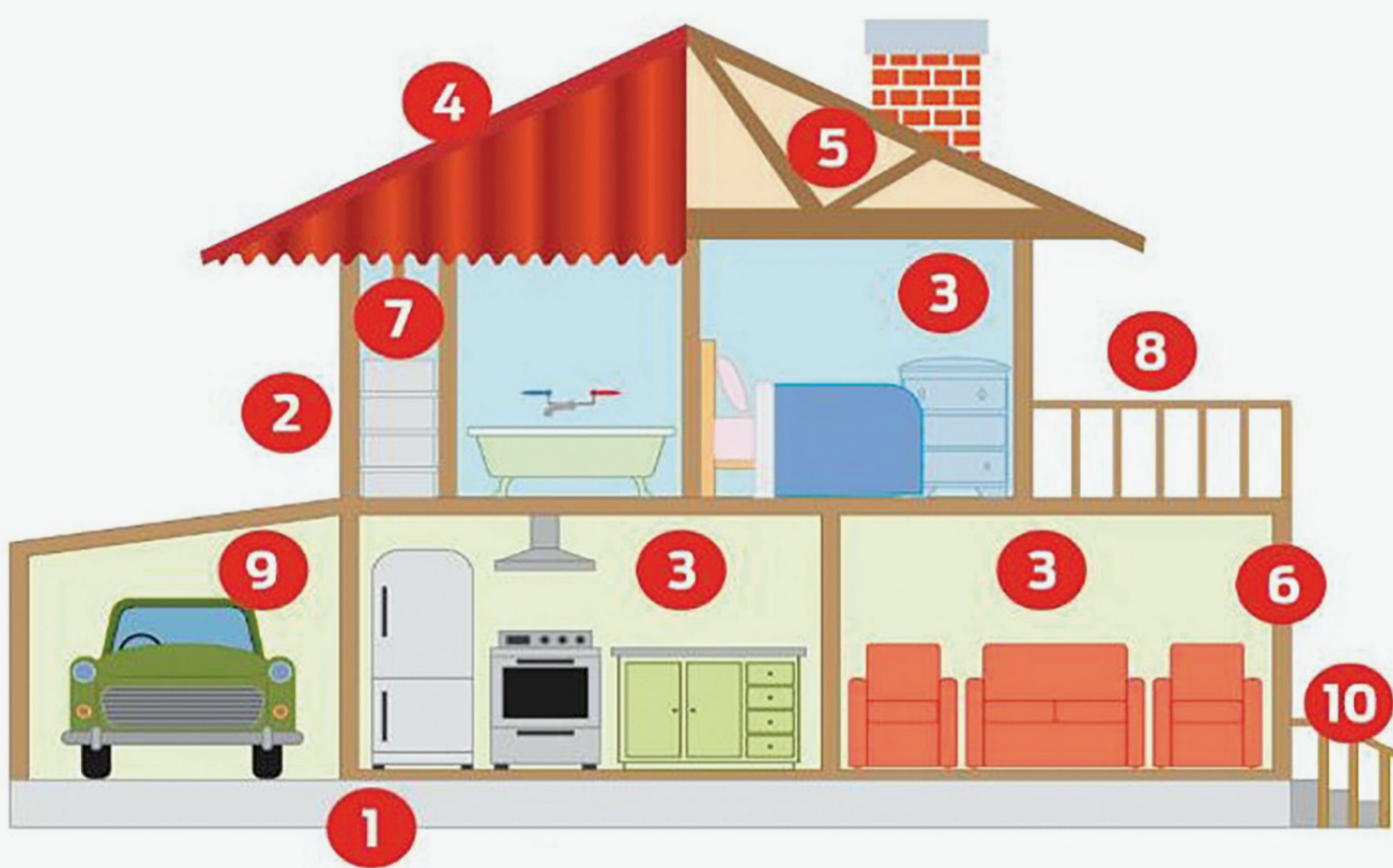

10. Paths, steps, ramps
